SUBJECT: Alberta and British Columbia Insurance Act changes

On July 1, 2012, changes to the Alberta and British Columbia Insurance Acts (Acts) come into effect. The changes include amendments to the provisions of the Acts applicable to life, accident and sickness, and group insurance contracts. In its July 15, 2011 Fact Sheet announcing the changes to the Alberta *Insurance Act*, the Government of Alberta indicated "These changes modernize the framework for insurance contracts, strengthen consumer protection, and address issues identified by stakeholders, including consumers, legal counsel and insurers."

Highlights

- Where required, we are amending our insurance and investment contracts
- We are introducing a new Beneficiary Designation/Direction to Pay for Critical Illness Benefits form to allow Owners to designate a beneficiary where permitted by law (currently BC, AB, MB, QC) or, where a beneficiary designation is not permitted by law, to appoint a payee for Critical Illness benefits
